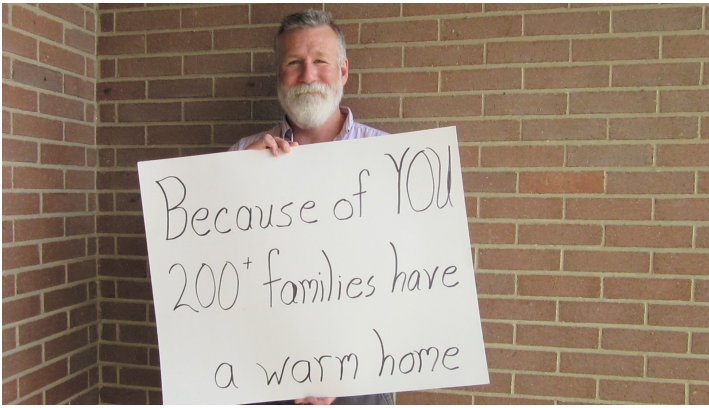

DIRECTIONS FOR FILLING OUT YOUR PLEDGE FORM

- 1. My Information:** Your information will not be sold. It is used to track pledges and payments as well as send thank you letters and occasional information pieces about the work being done with your generous pledge.
- 2. How I Prefer to Give:** You can donate through payroll deduction (each paycheck or one-time only). Payroll deductions will begin in January. One-time only will be taken from your first check in January. You can also donate by cash or check at the time the pledge form is completed.
- 3. My Investment Options:** Donations directed to My Community (your county) are used to award grants to local community programs through an application process. You may choose to direct your gift to one of our programs (endowment fund, diaper bank or Dolly Parton's Imagination Library). You may also choose to direct your gift to any tax exempt organization (restricted contribution). Please provide their address. You can also divide your gift between any or all options.
- 4. Landmark Society Members:** This section only needs completed if your total pledge is \$500 or more annually.
