Uinta County Public Health (Lyman Office): Offers vaccinations, STD testing, prenatal and postpartum care for mothers and infants, and wellness education. (307-787-3800)

Women, Infant, & Children (WIC) Program offers benefits to low-income women who are pregnant, breastfeeding, or who just had a baby, and families with children under the age of 5. Nutritious food items, as well as many other benefits, are available for many Wyoming families through WIC. Wraparound Solutions - serves as the Care Management Entity for youth with complex behavioral health conditions.
